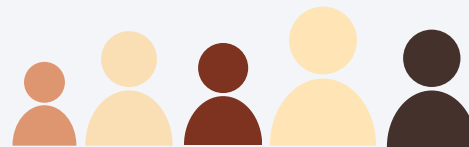
The Power of *Representation*
